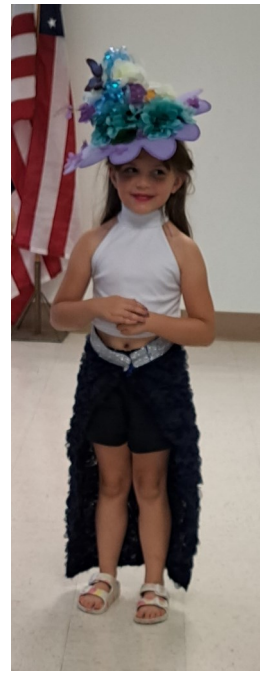
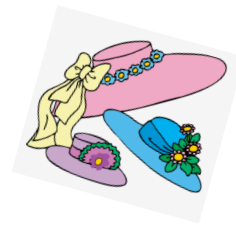

There were prize winners for the best hat and the most original hat!



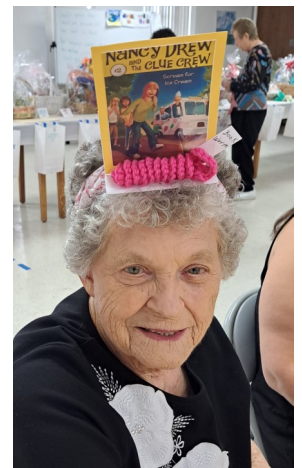

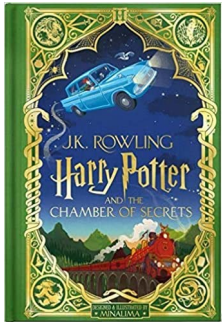
